## FOREWORD

Avenue des Arts Gallery is delighted to present the first solo exhibition of the international artist Marcos Marin in Hong Kong.

The artist will join the opening night showcasing exclusive paintings of landscape of the big world megalopolises as well as the symbolic portraits of the icons which he likes.

Recognized as master of the optical art, the works of this brazilian painter and sculptor are easy to recognize at first glance. He plays with optical effects and perspectives in order get the audience involved with his art pieces.

"My paintings do not define a time, but perpetuate a moment of glory that brings about an enchanted perspective" explains Marin.

Marcos Marin has first developed his artistic sensibility through piano. At a young age he started a career as a pianist and came to France in order to further his studies in music. In 1990, Marcos Marin meets Vasarely at the Cité Internationale des Arts de Paris. His carreer in optical art begins. In 2006, Marcos Marin meets the stylist and the sponsor, Pierre Cardin, who offers him the possibility of realizing works of large format in the studio of Lacoste. In the meantime, Marcos Marin works in Portugal with Stanley Ho within the framework of the 50th anniversary of the Casino of Estoril.

Marcos Marin is later invited to set his exhibit in Monaco and becomes the official artist of His Serene Highness Prince Albert II of Monaco.

He is elected member of the Academy of Fine Arts in Portugal in 2011.

Today, Marin's artworks can be found in public spaces, galleries and private collections all over the world.

# ART CRITICS

While the standpoint of the art changes within the beholder's eye, Marin's artwork goes beyond simple trompe l'oeil that is common amongst most kinetic artists. Marin's distinctive familiarity with the human perception along with his unrivaled and unparalleled knowledge with optical art generates intense effects and visual shocks in the viewpoint of his artwork.

Unlike Vasarely, Marin goes beyond by drawing lines that complement natural human characteristics and movement. This novel technique breathes life into the human image; shadow effects bring about body and facial protrusion, unusual and uneven lines produce hair movement, and color differentiation generates draping effects in clothing. In combination, these effects not only symbolize iconic figures, but they also bring about an emotional presence of the celebrity.

As Proust quoted, "Our social personality is created by the thoughts of others," Marin masters the ability to understand how others perceive objects through his techniques and his aptitude of interpreting optical art.

Blaise PARINAUD Mitsukoshi Exhibition "Les Anneés Grace Kelly" Tokyo, Japan Marcos Marin's serigraphies, paintings and sculptures not only combine three-dimensional light, color and movement, but also bring about an interpersonal connection with the viewer. The portraits of contemporary celebrities come to life as soon as they are approached, and outdoor sculptures play with the surrounding setting to enhance environmental characteristics.

Marin places the viewer in a curious situation, where the viewer triangulates with the art piece in order to observe a variety of physical perspectives. Marin's artwork also leverages the laws of human perspective through color interaction. Portraying a balance between warm and cold colors, Marin's masterpieces create an unprecedented balance that brings the artwork to life, as the effects create spatial and three dimensional appearances, and subsequent movements.

Along with breakthrough and eye-catching optical illusion methodology, Marin brings about Vasarely's 'fourth dimension,' as his technical wisdom of combining layering, colors and emotion highlights responsive and transcendental effects that resurrect iconic figures.









# BIOGRAPHY

Marcos Marin is born in Brazil on September 12, 1967. From the age of five years, Marcos follows classical piano lessons at the music conservatory in Sao Paulo and quickly starts a career as a virtuoso pianist. He came to study music in France in Angers and during this period, became passionate about painting. At the Cité des Arts Angers and during this period, became passionate about painting. During this decade, Marcos Marin plays an important role in the cultural development between Brazil and France for the IAA UNESCO. In 2000, he moved to the USA in Miami Beach, where he set up his studio. 2003 is the year of his first monumental sculpture. It is shown at the Coconut Grove Convention Center on the "Best of Florida".

In 2004 he met Delphine Pastor, who, seduced by his talent, invited him to exhibit at Monaco. There, at the inauguration, he presented a portrait of Princess Grace, now on official monument dedicated to his father. This monumental work is unveiled on January 18, 2006 at the entrance of the Cirque de Fontvieille.

In 2006, Marcos Marin meets stylist and mécène Pierre Cardin, who offers him the possibility of large format art works in Lacoste's studio. Meanwhile, Marcos Marin works in Portugal with Stanley Ho for the fiftieth anniversary of the Estoril Casino. The sponsor will provide the artist two medals of honor; one thanking the artist for the exhibition at the gallery of the Casino and the other for Stanley Ho's portrait made in Macao.

In 2009, invited to Japan under the Japan-Brazil friendship, the artist gets the recognition for all of his work. In November 2011, Alain Deion co-signs the artist's sculpture, who, in the same year, was appointed a member of the Lisbon Academy of Fine Arts and Letters (Portugal).

In 2012, a new monumental sculpture «Princess Grace» was unveiled during the Art Fair «Art Monaco» and after installed for the public into the olive's trees gardens of Cap Martin following the desire of the His Serene Highness Prince Albert II of Monaco.

The City of Roquebrune Cap Martin (France) commissioned also Marin to create the monument «Coco Chanel» for the «Hall of fame», public collection of the city.

In October of the same year, Marcos Marin participates in the project " 3 Images of Russia" in Moscow and won the first prize of the Russian Academy of Fine Arts.

In 2013, at Ponta Delgada, Azores island in Portugal, Marin unveiled the public monument «Joao de Deus» honoring this pioneer of the education in Portugal and made a Monumental Solo Exhibition at Borgo San Felice in Toscary in collaboration with the Foundation Prince Albert II of Monaco.

The artist lives and works in Monaco.
